Just Passing Through

Making the most of minimal resources



This is a great activity to present first to individuals, and then to teams. Synergy, collaboration and ultimately a successful team effort are only an index card and a pair of scissors away.

The challenge of Just Passing Through is to create an opening in an index card big enough for any person to pass completely through, without further damage to the card. You can begin this puzzle as an individual challenge and then encourage participants to collaborate and work together to create the best concepts possible (sharing best practices).

Supplies You will need an index card and a pair of school scissors for each person or team.

Teachable Moments Even small things can be made bigger, if you just know how. When the average person reads this challenge and then looks at the index card, their reaction is often "No way!" Activities that look impossible, but are not, are excellent methods for expanding our horizons. This is also a useful activity for teaching the concept of making do with what you have or making a little go a
