For starters, you can type your school and council data, along with your project summaries directly onto the PDF application. If your computer has the full Adobe Acrobat program, you will also be able to save your application after you print it. You will also find a separate “Checklist of the Evidence” your student council is asked to collect for its portfolio. The numbers for each piece of evidence correspond directly with the NASC Standard that you will also find listed in the application packet. *All 2008 Gold Chapter schools should apply for this NASC honor* Application deadline is February 15th, 2009.
