

ADVANCED REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR HOME SCHOOL ADVISOR

1. Delegates must be Seniors in the NEXT school year.
2. The delegates must have attended BASIC.
3. This is **NOT** an activity for **all** who have attended BASIC. This workshop is for personal growth and development. Delegates will have the opportunity to work through “sharing activities” that display how they work in group settings. Delegates shouldn’t be super ‘Quiet persons.’ If they are not willing to communicate with strangers, this workshop is NOT recommended.
4. You need to be aware that if you turn in the maximum number of delegates (2 delegates per session or a maximum of 6), you must rank order those who **must** attend. The size of each workshop is limited (50) and not all 6 may be selected to attend. A rank of 1 will indicate your 1st choice and 6 your last choice. You will place this ranking on the student recommendation form. If the workshop numbers have exceeded the number of delegates allowed, cuts will have to be made by a committee that reviews the applications. The committee will look at the following: date application was received, recommendation from sponsor and principal, responses to questions, and number of delegates that the school has sent.
5. Advisors are to make sure all blanks are completed. It is very important that the student has indicated which month of BASIC she/he attended, the year, council advisor, council JC, and council #.
6. The student delegate **MUST** rank all the workshops in order of preference for attending. Most of the time first or second choices of dates are possible. No dates, however, are guaranteed. If a student knows that she/he cannot attend a session because of major conflicts, this should be indicated. Sometimes though those students who can only attend one session will be the ones that are cut.
7. There are no substitutes at **ADVANCED**. Switching dates is discretionary.
8. Registration forms must have a method of payment included. A school PO is acceptable.
9. Make sure The **ADVANCED** recommendation form is returned with the registration form. This form should be placed in a sealed envelope and mailed with registration form, health form, and payment. (It is suggested that the advisor mail all the forms.) Incomplete applications are not considered for enrollment. The advisor and principal complete the recommendation form.
