WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

BASIC WORKSHOP

This is a WORKshop—not just another convention or camp. Delegates are expected to have the maturity and motivation to participate actively in planned activities and improve their leadership abilities. The delegates will spend 10-12 hours daily learning and practicing leadership skills in hypothetical student council groups. These groups simulate the work of delegates' local councils or groups, where advisors and council members work closely together to achieve goals. Major skill development sessions will be offered in the following areas:

- Large and small group processes
- Communications
- Project Planning
- Problem Solving
- Leadership Styles
- Interpersonal Relations
- Team Building
- Self Esteem
- Goal Setting
- Fund Raising/School Activities

ADVANCED WORKSHOP

This workshop is designed for Senior student leaders who have attended BASIC and are eager to further develop their skills. Students have the opportunity to discover more about their individual styles as they work through leadership situations. Teambuilding activities, advanced leadership skill training, and a High Ropes Course are part of the Advanced Workshop

WHO MAY ATTEND AND COSTS

BASIC

Any student who has completed grades 9, 10, 11 is eligible to attend. Each school may send up to 10 delegates per session. Schools must be members of OASC to attend. (If your school is not a member of OASC, contact Gary Oberste, Executive Director, goberste@bkelleyhs.org)

ADVANCED

The ADVANCED Workshop is available only to those students who have previously attended BASIC and are **SENIORS** for the next school year. Since there are limited spaces for each session, students are advised to register early to get selected session. Only two students from a given school may attend per session. ADVANCED expands and reinforces the leadership concepts of BASIC while giving multiple experiences for individual growth and opportunity.

COST

The fee for each BASIC and ADVANCED Workshop is \$265. This fee covers room and board, insurance, workshop manual, printed materials, supplies, staff expenses, final banquet, special activities, t-shirt, and university facility and equipment costs. Student will need spending money for snacks, and optional purchase of a DVD.

LOCATION

BASIC Workshops are held on the campus of NWOSU in Alva. All meetings and meals will take place on Campus. Delegates will be housed in university dormitories with supervision by the workshop staff members.

STAFF INFO

The teaching staff of the workshop includes adults with numerous experiences throughout the state. All staff members are well qualified and have dedicated themselves to developing student leaders. Each staff member is committed to making the workshop experience valuable and profitable for every delegate. For each group there is an Adult Advisor and JC (Junior Counselor). Dorm deans and workshop directors complete the staff.
