



BASIC Leadership Workshop

Hosted by the Oklahoma Association of Student Councils

Mission Statement: To develop student leaders by offering training and hands-on experiences so the students can enhance their local student council and school culture while preparing themselves for future leadership roles in their schools, careers, and communities.

Basic Workshop

This is a **WORKshop** - not just another convention or camp. Delegates in grades 10-12 are expected to have maturity and motivation to participate actively in planned activities and improve their leadership abilities. The delegates will spend 10-12 hours daily learning and practicing leadership skills in hypothetical student council groups. These groups simulate the work of delegates' local council or groups where advisors and council members work closely together to achieve goals. Major skill development sessions will be offered in the following areas:

- Large and Small Group Processes
- Communications
- Project Planning
- Problem Solving
- Leadership Styles
- Interpersonal Relations
- Team Building
- Group Dynamics
- Goal Setting
- School Activities



WHO MAY ATTEND: Any Student who has completed grades 9, 10, or 11. Each school may send up to **12 delegates per session**. Schools **MUST** be members of the OASC to attend. A student may only attend Basic one time.

COST: Basic is **\$400** fee covers university housing, all meals, workshop manual, printed materials, supplies, special activities, t-shirt, university facility and equipment costs.

LOCATION: Northwestern Oklahoma State University Alva, Oklahoma

WHAT TO BRING:

- All bedding for a twin size bed: Sheets, Pillow, Blanket, etc
- Bring a towel, wash cloth, blanket, fan, comfort items
- Personal Toilet Articles: hair dryers, hand soap, soap, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrush, shower shoes, etc
- Backpack, pencils/pens
- Snacks and water for your dorm at night
- School Appropriate Clothing: recommend school t-shirts and shorts
- Tennis Shoes are required for some activities
- Outdoor wear for outside activities
- \$20 for dorm key deposit
- Money (\$50-\$60) for OASC or NWOSU Merchandise
- Bring several masks and hand sanitizer

The application form and health form **MUST** be submitted by the School Advisor. Forms must be signed by student, parent, advisor, and principal. Registration forms are considered incomplete unless signed and accompanied by payment. The deadline for registration forms is May 1. If the payment or PO is not received by May 10th, there will be a \$50 late fee per person. Once the approvals have been submitted, the delegate will receive a confirmation letter containing what to bring, when, and where to check in, and other important details. There will also be a \$50 fee assessed for changing sessions. You may contact the workshop registrar for assistance.
