  - Presented goals, and the overview of the platform, how it would work, benefits to the OASC, as well as, application process/video ideas
  - Suggestions were made and clarifying questions were asked by the board members
  - Goal set for February 22nd to have application ready for committee members
- State Vice President, Madison Lake, Piedmont High School shared her platform proposal -OASC Unity
  - Presented vision, purpose, overview of the how it would be put into place by using videos, growing the OASC by reaching out to nonmember schools, and use of social media
  - Suggestions were made and clarifying questions were asked by the board members
  - Goal set for February 22nd to have a list of 32 schools that could be contacted to grow the OASC



- Summer Camps (BASIC & Advanced) were discussed- what will they look like if we can have them, CDC guidelines must be followed, how will mask guidelines be enforced, what about temperature screenings, group sizes, number in dorms - is it financially feasible to hold an in person camp following guidelines, what is the liability for the OASC, how will cancellations be handled (due to pandemic), also discussed feedback from BASIC survey sent to advisors
