**GOLD AND PLATINUM CHAPTER OF EXCELLENCE**  
**August 1, 2023-July 31, 2024**

**Purpose**

The purpose of this project is to recognize Student Councils that have done an outstanding job in their schools. These are student councils, which have a well-rounded program, and are active on the local, district, and state level.

**Awards and Recognition**

There is a total possible score of 440 points available on this application. High School Student Councils receiving a total of 280-329 points on the criteria will receive a Gold Chapter Award of Excellence from the OASC and will be recognized at the OASC Annual State Convention. High School Student Councils receiving 330 points or higher on the criteria will receive a Platinum Chapter Award of Excellence from the OASC and will be recognized at the OASC Annual State Convention.

**How to Submit Report:**

This report is to be submitted to your district advisor to determine the Gold and Platinum Chapter Councils. The due date is following the year of completed projects. Activities from August 1st to July 31st may be included for consideration. Any project falling outside of this time-line may be submitted with an explanation as to its application. Please fill out the form carefully, being sure to include attachments where they are needed.
