GENERAL INFORMATION AND REGISTRATION INFORMATION ALL SESSIONS!

ADVANCED -A Leadership Workshop sponsored by the Oklahoma Association of Student Councils, a five day practicum where student leaders from across the state rally to celebrate the leadership potential in themselves and others, a seminar in which student leaders discover ways to provide opportunity for every member of a student body to feel a part of the campus.

This workshop is only for seniors (entering their senior year) that have previously attended (or will be attending prior to Advanced) the Basic Leadership Workshop hosted by the OASC.

Session 1: June 18-22, 2023

Session 2: June 19-23, 2023

Session 3: July 19-23, 2023

Session 4: July 20-24, 2023

All sessions of Advanced are at the *University of Oklahoma* in Norman at Cross Hall

HOW TO APPLY:

- The advisor must complete the online registration found on the OASC Website
- The delegate and advisor must obtain required signatures and health forms.
- Mail (with your registration fee or a copy of your purchase order) postmarked by May 1st to **OASC Advanced Leadership Workshop, Harlee Davis, 501 St James PL, Newcastle, OK 73065-4082**
- **WHEN TO APPLY:** Online by **May 1, 2023** and all registration forms, signatures and payments must be postmarked by **May 10, 2023**. A late fee of \$50.00 may be assessed if postmarked after that date. It is important to apply early to guarantee a delegate spot.
- **COST:** Advanced cost is \$300.00 per delegate
- **EXTRA FEES:** \$ 50.00 late fee if applicable \$ 25.00 Change of session fee may be assessed. **REFUNDS:** if canceled before: May 10 for June sessions and June 10 for July sessions.
- Registration form will not be complete without payment.
- **OTHER:** After registration the delegate will receive further forms and information regarding *The University of Oklahoma Minor on Campus policy and agreement*, as well as the OAR (ropes course) waiver and permission forms. These will need to be returned at registration.

OASC ADVANCED ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All delegates attending ADVANCED will abide by the following ADVANCED LEADERSHIP WORKSHOP RULES.

- 1. No tobacco, vaping, drugs or alcohol.
- 2. No delegate will leave the campus without permission of the Workshop Directors.
- 3. No outside guests—adult guests will need permission from the Workshop Director.
- 4. Dorm rules, University Campus rules and general OASC rules will be specified and clarified by the Workshop Director and Workshop Facilitators. These rules will be presented to all delegates and will be strictly enforced.
- 5. Delegates are liable for any damage done to the University property by the delegate(s).
- 6. Delegates realize that they are under the supervision of any adult connected with the workshop and that if they fail to abide by any of the rules, they will be sent home.
- 7. Delegates realize that if they are to receive the greatest benefits from the Leadership Workshop, they must be willing to participate actively in all phases of the workshop. **YOU CANNOT TAKE COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT AND ATTEND ADVANCED AT THE SAME TIME. YOU MUST ATTEND ALL SESSIONS IN ORDER TO BE A WORKSHOP DELEGATE.**
- 8. Delegates have parental consent to travel to and from the workshop as arranged by their school advisor. In no case will they be considered under the workshop supervision before registration or after final assembly.
- 9. An infraction of these rules, according to Article XIV-B of the OASC Constitution, may require that a student be sent home (at the parent's expense) and the member school may be placed on probation for one (1) year. This means no participation in any OASC or NASC Conference, workshop, or meeting. The principal, advisor and parents shall be informed of the infraction.
- 10. Students can attend ADVANCED only once. If your school attempts to register a student who has previously attended ADVANCED; your school will go on probation.
- 11. All students attending ADVANCED must be SENIORS and must have attended BASIC.
- 12. No Hats - Anytime in any building or during sessions: Please leave them in your dorm room. You may wear them on Ropes Course
- 13. No Evidence Policy - Leave everywhere we are better than when we came.
- 14. Dress Code – Modest and Appropriate. If asked to change by a staff member, please respect and respond to their request.
- 15. Cell Phones – Please have them on silent and put away during any session or activity. They may be checked/ used at break times, meals and dorm time.
- 16. Confidentiality Policy – Understanding Advanced is a safe zone but if information is gained that: a) You are or are threatening to hurt yourself b) You are or are threatening to hurt someone else c) Someone is threatening to hurt you. We will notify proper individuals to provide needed assistance
