Awards and Recognition

High School Student Councils receiving a total of 230 or more points on the criteria will receive a Gold Chapter Award of Excellence from the OASC and will be recognized at the OASC Annual State Convention.

How to Submit Report:

This report is to be submitted to your district advisor to determine the Gold Chapter Councils. The due date is following the year of completed projects. Activities from August 1, 2022 – July 31, 2023 may be included for consideration. Any project falling outside of this time-line may be submitted with an explanation as to its application. Please fill out the form carefully, being sure to include attachments where they are needed.
